

CURRENT RULES FOR THE REGION OF LOMBARDIA*

As of 19.05.2021 subject to change

PROCEDURES IN PLACE DUE TO THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY

- You must confirm the following three statements to be allowed entrance into Piantelle:
 - ✓ You have **not** shown any flu like symptoms in the last **14 days**. This includes cough, sore throat, fatigue, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea and/or vomit.
 - You have **not** been in contact with someone who has tested positive to COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
 - You read and accept the rules as stated below in order to ensure your safety and the safety of others.

LOCAL RULES

- Italy uses a traffic light system. Red, Orange and Yellow according to regions. We are currently in the Yellow.
- Face-masks must be worn in closed public places and in open public places such as city centers
 where it is not possible to socially distance. This does not apply to children under 6, or when
 exercising strenuous sports. Keep a mask with you at all times.
- Local restaurants and bars are open for lunch and dinner outside only until the 1st June then also inside. The Campsite restaurant has no restrictions on time or location. Maximum 4 people per table
- There is a curfew from 11pm to 5am during which time you can only move around for emergencies, or work. This will be from midnight from 1st June. From the 21st June there will be no curfew at all.
- **Gyms** and **pools** have reopened. **Amusement parks** on the 15th June and **theatres**, **cinemas** and **concerts** have reopened with limits on numbers and pre-assigned seating.
- Anyone with **COVID19 symptoms** must notify the local authorities by calling 1500, isolate yourself and **not** go to the Emergency Room.
- Group gatherings are not allowed.
 - You do not need to quarantine on arrival if one of these applies:
 - A negative COVID test done within 48 hours before entry into Italy
 - You have recovered from COVID in the last 6 months and have antibodies
 - You have had all doses of your COVID vaccine.

 - You should also Declare to the local authorities that you are here. This can be done following this <u>link</u>.

CAMPSITE RULES

RECEPTION

- **Check-in**: One person per group or family must do the check in. Maximum of **three** people will be allowed in the reception at any time. Others must wait outside.
- Hand Washing: People entering reception must clean their hands with provided hand gel.



• Face masks must be worn.

RESTAURANT

- You need to wear your face mask when not at the table.
- Fewer tables now ensure 1 meter between each person (so book your table!).
- Maximum 4 people per table (unless everyone is from the same family).
- **Temperature** is checked on entrance, to not be over 37,5°c.
- "Home" Delivery options will be given to you at reception. You may have to pick up your order at a designated time if there are no slots available.

POOL

- Maximum 75 people allowed in the big pool at any one time. Maximum of 19 in the baby pool.
- 2.5 m distance must be maintained in the water.
- In the Solarium **sun beds and parasols** are spaced at the **correct** safety distance and cannot be moved.
- You must shower before entering the pool.
- The lifeguard may ask you to **exit the water** or block entrance to the pool area if the limits have been reached.
- All other swimming pool regulations apply (swimming nappies for children if not potty trained, no food or drinks in the pool area, no smoking in the pool area etc).

GAMES

- Children over 6 need to wear a face covering.
- **Hand gel** is provided for use.
- Parents must ensure that children understand social distancing.
- We recommend you wash children's hands often.

PITCHES

- You must maintain the **security distance** of 1 meter between you and your neighboring pitch.
- The door or opening to your tent, camper, caravan, must be set up so that you have at least 3 meters between your door and your neighbors' door. We may ask you to move your tent, camper or caravan if you do not follow this rule.

BATHROOMS

- Every other sink, WC and shower will be closed, to guarantee fewer people in the buildings and less contact. The security distance of 1 meter must be maintained anyway.
- Maximum 4 people at any time in the bathrooms
- We have upgraded the **cleaning procedures** used to ensure all surfaces are disinfected regularly.
- We clean the bathrooms at least three times a day.
